## 76. CONSIDERATION OF PLANNING MATTERS

The Clerk had circulated details of planning applications decided since the last meeting.

**RESOLVED** that the following comments be made:

P19/09496/F: Little Normeads, Golden Valley Lane, Bitton. Erection of single storey rear extension and installation of 2 front balconies to facilitate change of use from dwelling (Class C3) to holiday accommodation (sui generis)

Councillors requested that conditions be applied to any planning permission granted to ensure use of the property would be limited to holiday accommodation (eg no lettings during January, time limit of 6 weeks for any one person hiring the accommodation, etc). Councillors also sought reassurance that sufficient parking is available for potentially large numbers of vehicles with adequate space for turning and good access arrangements.

P19/10431/F: Biddecombe Cottage, Beach Lane, Beach. Replacement of garage door with window and installation of 1 roof light to facilitate garage conversion.

The comments of the Parish Council are No objections.

P19/10660/TCA: 3 Church Lane, Bitton. Works to reduce 1 Japanese Maple tree by 1 – 2 metres and cut 1 Cherry tree back to previous points. All in Conservation Area
