Councillor Scudamore noted that application P21/05366/F – Land at Chief Trading Post had appeared on the Circulated Schedule. Councillors noted that the affordable housing had been reduced to 18 from 20.

Mendip House, North Stoke Lane. Works to fell 1 no. Goat Willow 1 no. Ash and 1 no. Black Walnut, works to 2 no. Beech trees to crown reduce by 3 meters all round covered by SG/TR 117 and dated 28/05/1968.

The comments of the Parish Council are No Objection subject to the views of the South Gloucestershire Council Tree Officer.

P22/03981/F

Oldland Dental Practice, 206 High Street, Oldland Common. Erection of a single storey rear and first floor rear/side extensions to form enlarged waiting room and decontamination room (Class E). Erection of 1 no. bike stand.

The comments of the Parish Council are No Objection.

P22/04100/HH

12 Brendon Close, Oldland Common. Erection of single storey rear extension, two storey and first floor side extension to provide additional living accommodation.

Bitton Parish Council Object to this application. The extension is not subserving to the main building. There is no detail on the application about the additional parking arrangements required.

P22/04201/TCA

Hollisters, Kites Farm, Upton Cheyney. Works to reduce lateral spread of 3 no. lime trees by 3m and fell 2 no. ash trees. Works also to remove 2 low limbs on north elevation and lowest limb of south elevation of 1 no. ash tree. All trees situated in the Bitton Conservation Area.
