The Clerk notified the Committee of the predicted Election costs for 2023 being £13,020.00. Enough money will need to be placed in the budget to cover this. Each budget heading was discussed individually, and a draft budget formed to put forward to Full Council.

Full Council to consider the following: -

- 1) Dropping the Newsletter altogether in favour of the free page in The Week In.
- 2) Placing the underspend on Salary in Earmarked Reserves to cover any shortfall in Salary next year.
- 3) Consider what percentage increase we feel is necessary on the precept 2% or 3%. The Clerk to provide Full Council with those figures and what affect each would have on the reserves.
